


Small Flat File Sander

The locking slide is removed by sliding it off as shown here. You may need to use a little extra upward pressure if you have sandpaper on the file sander.



Cut a piece of sandpaper that is approximately 5/8" wide by 11" long. Fold the strip in half and place it over the top of the sanding file as shown here. Start sliding the sliding lock downward **Large Flat File Sander**

Cut a piece of sandpaper that is approximately 1" wide by 11" long. Fold the strip in half and place it over the top of the Slide sanding file as shown here. Start downward sliding the sliding lock downward

Continue sliding the lock over the sandpaper strip on the file until it firmly grips the sandpaper and holds it in place as shown here. You are now ready to use the flat sanding file!
