Choose the extension length you would like the Long Bore to reach. With the locking screw removed, thread the rods together and tighten with two wrenches as shown above.



Once the rods have been tightened with the wrenches, re-insert the locking set screw into rod hole and secure. This is done to prevent the rods from loosening during use.

Install Forstner Bit



Once you are setup for your desired length, insert your choice of forstner bit in to the forsnter bit holder (the rod with two set screws). Secure the forstner bit by tightening to two set screws using a hex key wrench.





Insert the assembled Long Bore rod with the #2 morse tapered end into your lathe tailstock. With your project mounted on your lathe, turn the lathe on (appx. 800-1200 rpm depending on size of the forstner bit) and slowly feed the forstner bit into the center of your stock piece.





When your finished using the Long Bore rods, remember to remove the locking screws before dis-assembly. Failure to do so may damage the threads of the rods and void any and all warranties that apply.
