Safety First



Turn off Power

Disconnect machine from power source before making any adjustments.



Ear Protection

Always wear proper ear protection when working with machinery.



CAUTION
Sharp

Use caution when handling sharp objects (saw blades, router bits, drill bits and so on). Use protective gloves whenever possible.



Eye Protection

Always wear proper eye protection when working with machinery and tools.

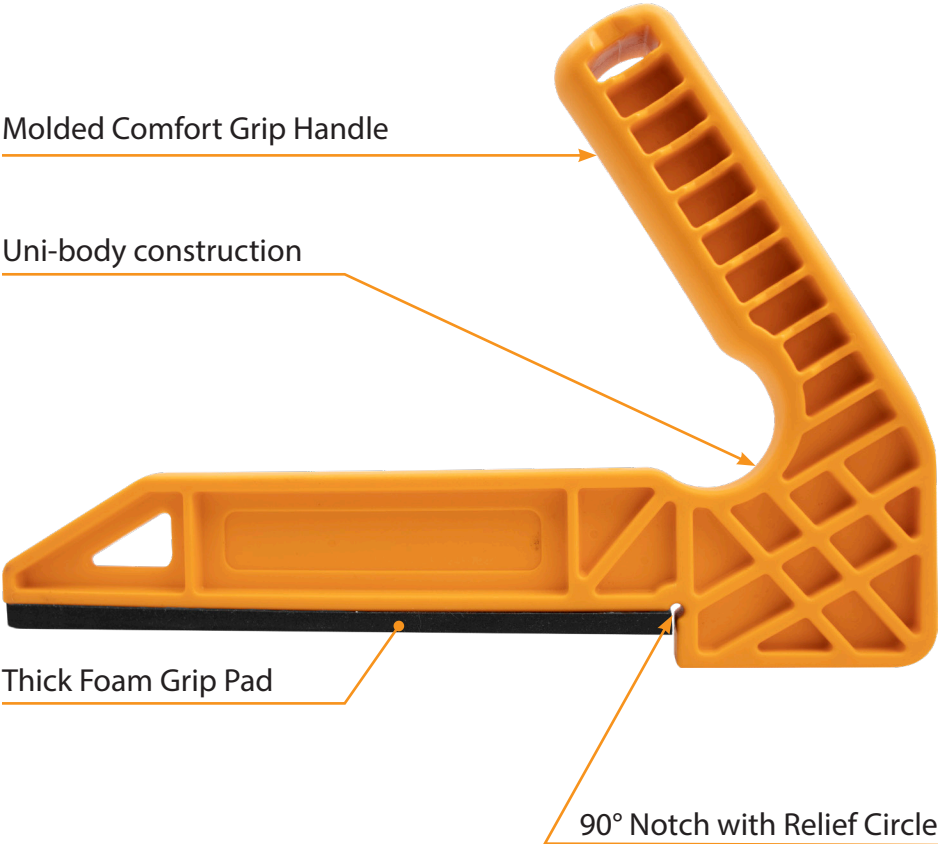


Respiratory

Deluxe Push Stick



Hook the Back End of Your Stock



This push stick has a 90 degree notch with a relief circle cut out. This helps “hook” the back end of your stock much better than standard styles of push sticks.



Always keep fingers a safe distance away from cutters and blades when operating machinery

Receptive Foam Pad for More Control



Also featured on these push sticks is the foam lined base. This helps provide you with even more control while feeding the stock through the blade. It also prevents slipping which can sometimes occur with standard style push sticks.

Use with a Featherboard



When used with a featherboard, the push stick becomes even more useful. The sideways pressure from the featherboard, along with the push stick from behind the stock provides the user with a safer more efficient way to cut narrow stock on a table saw.

Keep the Push Foam Pad Clean



Before each use, inspect the foam pad on the bottom of the push stick. Make sure it is clean and debris free. We recommend using warm water on a cotton or micro-fiber cloth to wipe the pad clean. Make sure pad is completely dry before using.
